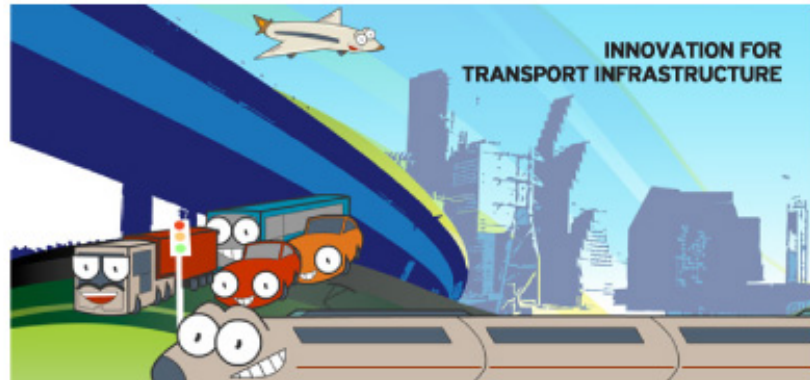

This fourth issue focuses on **international collaboration** and the **implementation of results**, as well as the FEHRL highlights of TRA2014 and includes articles on the [TRA Visions](#), [FOSTER-Road](#), [PROS](#), [ROSANNE](#), [ECOLABEL](#), [AllBack2Pave](#), [TRIMM](#), [SMARTRAIL](#), [SAFELIFE-X](#), [INCRIS](#) and [SUP&R ITN](#) projects.



Otherwise, FEHRL members have been very busy preparing proposals for the [Horizon 2020](#) and [Infravation](#) Calls. The March Horizon 2020 Call was heavily oversubscribed and FEHRL is now working to keep funding for R&D&I in engineering solutions for the maintenance of the road network with a focus on adaptability, automation and resilience.

FEHRL is also collaborating with key European transport infrastructure partners and others to integrate road infrastructure with cross/inter/multi-modality aspects. Besides, FEHRL is putting an emphasis on the exploitation and implementation of R&D&I results. To that end, FEHRL will sign a Memorandum of Understanding with key stakeholder CEDR at the already announced [FEHRL 25th anniversary](#) on **13th November** at FEHRL member BRRC's premises in Sterrebeek, Belgium.
